5. **Matters Arising**

5.1 Saputo update: Councillor Potter and the Chair continue to attend regular meetings with Saputo and the Environment Agency. The EA have confirmed they are happy with the progress of continuing works to improve the reduction of odour and noise from the water treatment works. Odour and noise reports are received regularly from Trewassa and the Inny Vale area however the records kept by Councillor Potter have shown a reduction in the number of reports made over a similar 3-month period 12 months ago.

6. Planning

6.1 Planning Application PA22/11417 Butterwell. Councillors supported the application.

6.2. The Chair has again contacted the planning department of Cornwall Council to request all planning correspondence is sent to her and not to the previous chair.
