1. **Declarations of interest** – Councillor Steed
2. **Minutes** of meeting held 6th March 2023 approved and signed. April meeting cancelled.

3. **Matters Arising:**

3.1. Chair to contact Mr Tippet for a quote for works discussed.

3.2. Turn out for Coronation mugs was low. It was brought to our attention not everyone had received their Davidstow Parish Magazine. Mugs are still available for those who missed distribution day. **Action:** All to get the message out.

4. **Standing orders suspended** to allow Mr Gill to participate in a discussion around Farm plastic waste and fly tipping in general. The dilapidated condition of some of the buildings on the airfield were also discuss. There has been a number of concerns raised about the danger to livestock, people and wildlife. **Standing orders resumed**

5. **Planning –**

5.1. PA23/02631 – Existing agricultural building to form self-contained annex and home for use in connection with the adjoining approved dwelling. Unfortunately, this application is unavailable on Cornwall Councils website. The Parish Council were therefore unable to comment.

6. **Saputo update** - Councillor Potter gave an update on Saputo works progress. They are on time and are hoping to complete before end of November 2023.

6.1. EA Consultation: Councillors have sought the views of members of the parish. It was felt the PC and the community would have been better placed to comment once current works were successfully completed. **Action:** Chair to construct a response for Councillors approval.

7.1. Public - Mr Gill expressed concern of a vehicle parked out on the moor with a dog and puppies running loose. The dog appeared to be nasty and caused both him and his wife to fear for their safety. Unfortunately, they were unable to get a number for the vehicle as they were keen to get away.
